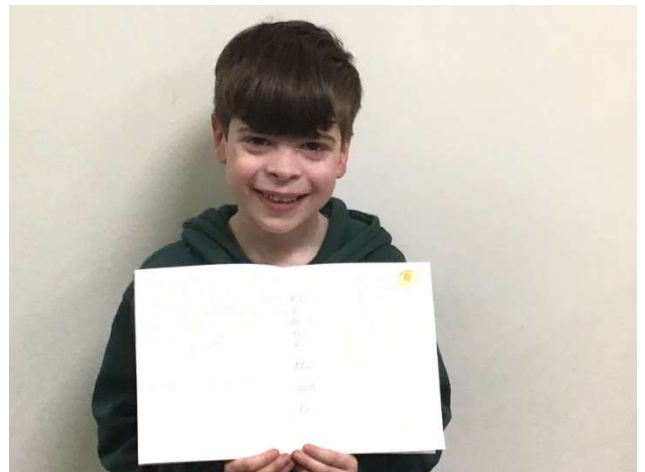
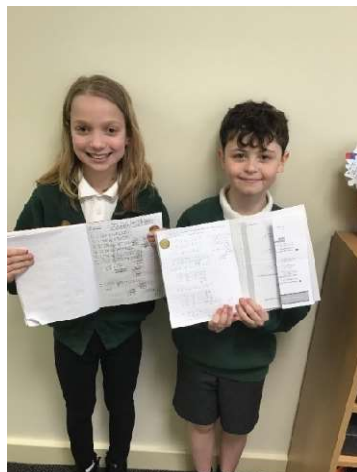
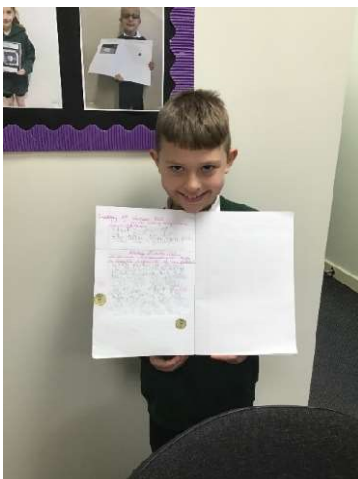
## Music For Schools
