We have had another exciting week in Foundation learning about superheroes. In literacy we wrote about Batman! In maths we learned about the language of length and height, and we compared and measured different superheroes.

Easter Activities

Just a reminder of our Easter activities that we told you about in last week's newsletter;

- **Tuesday 28th March; Easter bonnet parade.** The children need to make an Easter bonnet at home and bring it in on this day. There will be a parade in the hall at 2.30pm and parents are invited. We will sing you some Easter and springtime songs. There will be prizes for the winning boy and girl in each class plus a chocolaty treat for everyone!
- **Wednesday 29th March 2023; Easter Egg Hunt.** This is run by the PTA. The children need to bring an Easter Egg and £1. They will be hunting around the school for an egg that matches a raffle ticket number, and the Easter Bunny will be visiting to help us hunt!
- **Friday 31st March 2023; Cross Country Competition.** This takes place in the afternoon and parents are invited to come along. Foundation will be the first year group to run from the school field out onto the rugby pitch and back to the field. Each year group will take a turn to run a progressively longer course, and there will be a medal ceremony on the key stage two playground at the end of the day.
